

Security Feature of One Thousand Taka :



Obverse -National Shaheed Minar

Reverse -Curzon Hall, Dhaka University

Size-160x72mm

Date of Issue : 27-10-2008

1. Optically variable ink (OVI): OVI used in the numeric Bengali inscription 5000 appears golden when looked directly and green when viewed obliquely.
2. Security thread: Holographic window type 4mm, wide security thread.
3. Microscopic printing: "BANGLADESH BANK 1000 TAKA" printed microscopically.
4. Note Number: Indifferent series number in Bengali accompanies Bengali & English serial number.
5. Latent image: Numeric Bengali inscription "1000".
6. Iridescent stripe: A vertical stripe on the back containing inscription "BANGLADESH BANK" with variable colour.
7. Intaglio printing.
8. Watermark: Watermark of water lily, Bangladesh Bank's monogram and English inscription 1000.
9. Dot for blind.
10. Paper: Durable paper with special coating and scattered fluorescent fibre.
11. Borderless printing.
